

Hi Gang

This is the first issue of the new year. I'd like to say that 2006 started out with a bang for me and all was well, but that would be a lie. If you've been a subscriber for any length of time you've heard me refer to my "boys". They would be my dogs Dakota and Teddy Bear. I'm sad to tell you that Teddy died on Jan 11th and I was so

depressed over his death I could not bring myself to publish.

He started getting sick right before New Year's Eve and I actually took him to the doctor New Year's Eve morning. He started with constipation, went to not eating or drinking water then throwing up and diarrhea. The vet at first thought he simply had a bacterial infection, gave me some antibiotics and sent me home. Later that same day the vomiting was out of control. I called the doctor again who told me to stop giving him the pills and meet him at the office Monday morning. By that time he was very sick. My vet put him on IV's, pumped him full of antibiotics, even opened him up to do exploratory surgery to make sure something was not lodged in his system, even though the x-rays showed nothing. When he opened him he found his intestines all red, swollen and inflamed. After trying to treat him for 4 days he told me I had to take him to a "internal specialist" or he would be dead within 4 days time. He was getting weaker by the day, as even the vet could not stop the vomiting. He also still had not eaten or drank but they were pumping him full of antibiotics. Nothing was working.

I did as instructed and took him to this 24/7 hospital where the surgeon said she had to open him up again and do a biopsy. She suspected cancer. I told her he did not have cancer as I spend more time with my dogs then people and I would have seen something like that coming on. He would not have went from fine to deaths door in one week. She insisted that was the next step and she wanted to put in a feeding tube for nourishment as it had been almost 9 days since he had last eaten. Italian Greyhounds have 0 body fat and he was losing the fight quickly. The plan was to bypass his stomach, since he was still vomiting, and put the tube right into his intestines.

To make a long story short he was in that hospital for 5 days and died at 1:10, they did CPR, and brought him back once but he died again at 1:20 am. They don't know for sure but they suspect he had Intestinal Bowel Disease. He always had a sensitive stomach, and would occasionally get bouts of diarrhea and vomiting but my vet said it was food allergies and to just play around with his food. We will never know for sure, but looking back this makes sense. It's similar to Crones Disease in people. There's no way I would have known he had it and without the proper diet and prescription meds it could have escalated to this.

After 7 years with Teddy I feel as if I lost my best friend. We were so close and often would just look at each other to communicate our thoughts. He was as sweet little man, very nervous and a bit on the slow side but I loved him dearly. Why he was taken away from me so young I will never understand but I guess that's how life is, there's a lot we don't get

and never will. After spending almost a week crying in bed over his loss I'm up and at em again trying to move past it. I won't tell you it's easy, it's hard, very hard. I loved that dog as if he was my son and there isn't one day that goes by I don't miss his little face. I think I'll always miss him and will carry this pain for a long time.

I did have him cremated and plan on putting him in a nice uhrn and placing it on a shelf under his photo and a poem I wrote for him. If you'd like to read it I did post it on my blog http://www.merlesworld.blogspot.com/

Some people say it was just a dog, but they're wrong. Ted taught me to be a better person. He taught me how to love completely. I only hope I can use his death to be an even better person then I was before as I think that would make him happy. Teddy, you'll always be my "little man" and I miss you daily. Thank you for spending the time you did with me, and I only hope I was able to give you half of what you gave to me.

I did go out the other day and get another dog. After almost 3 weeks of feeling sad and not knowing if I should get another one or not, I broke down and got an Italian Greyhound. It's a girl and I haven't named her yet. Dakota is excited at the prospect of having a sister. He's been really depressed since Teddy passed so I'm hoping this will help pull him out of his mourning. Did you know dogs mourn? I looked it up on the net and sure enough it takes them 4 to 8 weeks to get over the loss of their mate. If you have any ideas for a good name for her, please let me know. I wonder what she'll have to teach me.
