Jay's best friend, Taylor had an 8 foot bed in which we loaded the coffin and after having a service for him here drove the 3.5 hours for another service with his family and then to the cemetery. Luckily another family member had a plot and she donated it to Jay. It was next to her dead husband so I think it was very generous of her to give it to him. Where she's going to go now I don't know. Thank god for gifts of charity.

My brother in law was an Eskimo Indian so we're researching that angle to see if there is any "f-r-e-e money" to help with the burial costs. They have also put money jars in the local bars to help defray costs. At this point there is no money for a headstone but my mom said the ground has to settle for a year before they will put one up anyway. Who knows where the funds will come for that.

Jay might not have had any money but he was rich in spirit and always had a nice word for everyone he met. He was always willing to lend a hand and would give you the shirt off his back, even if it meant he had no shirt for himself. That's just the kind of guy he was. More people could learn from someone like him. I feel bad for my sister and her children. Death is a part of life but when it happens like this it just seems so senseless. His 7 year old was very close to him and I know she will miss her daddy dearly. I have vowed to do what I can to help but I am not a rich woman by any means. But if being there means anything, I promise I will be. Make sure you tell your loved ones you love them today. Who knows, it may be your last.
